The Upcoming Google Plus for iPad and iPod Touch

As an insider, I bet you must have learned that Apple have approved the Google+ app for the iPhone, and posted it to the App Store. This adds the much needed capability for uploading photos, and huddle - which allows you to group message between G+ mobile users just as easy as we

transfer

music from ipod to computer. If you're accustomed to the webapp this should be an easy switch as the two are basically the same.

What's more Google will offer a Google+ app for the iPad and iPod Touch "soon," a company product manager said today.

The stream is very similar to the web app. Swipe to left and you can see your incoming stream. Swipe to the right and you can see who is sharing things nearby, which is a great way to meet new people if I might add. Within the stream you can Check-In and Share items, and attach your geo-location if you'd like. The only thing missing within the stream is the ability to re-share items. I'd also like to note that the notifications work a lot better than on the web app.

"Please give us time. We will have support for all those devices soon," said Punit Soni, the lead product manger of Google+ for mobile, on his Google+ stream. Soni was responding to numerous questions -- and some complaints -- from users frustrated that the Google+ app released earlier Monday runs only on the iPhone.

His comment was part of a thread in which Soni urged the earliest adopters to remove Google+ from their iPhone.

Create Your Own Circles

Unlike Google's last big invite-only rollout of a social initiative - Google Wave - users will not be confounded on just what the heck you are supposed to with the service when signing up for the first time. From Friendster, Friendfeed, MySpace and Facebook, users are familiar with how a social platform is theoretically supposed to look. At its core level, Plus is not that much different. Yet, there is so much more. How do you get started with Google Plus? Let's break down the nuts and bolts.

One of the great differentiators between Twitter and Facebook is the "unbalanced" or "balanced" follow. Facebook was initially a two-way follow paradigm - I friend you, you friend me and we see each other's updates. This has been changed with the ability to "like" groups, brands and pages without them following you back. Twitter has always been a one-way follow - I follow you and you do not necessarily have to follow me back.

Moreover, posting a status update in Plus is not like sending a Tweet or updating Facebook. The core functions of an update are present - photos, links, video and location - but when you hit "share" it doesn't automatically post your message to everybody in your circles. You have the option to decide which circles your update is posted to, from individual groups to all circles, to extended circles, or just a single person.

After learning these, are you waiting for a Google Plus invite? Google is rolling out the service in waves and you can expect it to become a ubiquitous social option in the coming months. We have been playing with the service since getting invites yesterday and there are a lot of things to like about Google's new social initiative.

OS X Lion, It is What Makes a Mac a Mac

If you are a mac user, I bet you must have heard that Apple has released Mac OS X Lion on its Mac App Store and, as promised, the new operating system is selling for \$31.99.

Mac OS X Lion (version 10.7) is the eighth major release of Mac OS X, Apple's desktop and server operating system for Macintosh computers. Lion was released on July 20, 2011, as announced during Apple's third quarter 2011 earnings report. Apple's homepage and Mac OS X webpages refer to it as OS X Lion, without the "Mac", although Apple's press release for Lion's July release mainly uses "Mac OS X Lion" rather than "OS X Lion". Built on a rock-solid UNIX foundation, OS X is engineered to take full advantage of the technologies in every new Mac. And to deliver the most intuitive and integrated computer experience.

There's no going into an Apple store and buying a copy of this new OS for Intel-based Apple laptops and desktops on a DVD. Of course, If you really wan to have a dvd copy mac, you can use a dvd copy mac tool to help you. Mac OS X Lion - which touts more than 250 new features - is only available as a 3.49-gigabyte digital download. Apple store employees will, however, help with downloading Lion for those who stroll in.

Among the new features Lion is adding over its predecessor, OS X Snow Leopard, are new multi-touch trackpad features, including scrolling speed that varies depending on how fast you flick your fingers, pinching your fingers to zoom in on a web page or image (as you'd do on an touch screen smartphone or tablet) and new security features such as stepped-up hard drive encryption.

Lion is also ushering in a few new app-related features, too, such as automatic file saving when a user closes a program, full-screen views, and iPad-like Launchpad feature to organise and view apps as an array of icons across a screen.

The new version of OS X is a bit of a test for digital distribution methods at Apple, which is also prepping for the fall release of the Cupertino, California, company's iCloud services.

A preview of Lion was publicly unveiled at Apple's "Back to the Mac" event on October 20, 2010. It will bring many developments made in Apple's iOS, such as an easily-navigable display of installed applications, to the Mac, and will include support for the Mac App Store, as introduced in Mac OS X Snow Leopard version 10.6.6. On February 24, 2011, the first developer's preview of Lion

(11A390) was released to subscribers of Apple's developers program. Other developer previews were subsequently released, with Lion Preview 4 (11A480b) being released at WWDC 2011. Lion achieved Golden Master status on July 1, 2011.

Apple [AAPL] will ship OS X Lion exclusively via the Mac App Store next month. The company has posted an extensive list of 250 new features and improvements within the OS. We've found some more information, including clarification that previous concerns are answered by news it will be possible to download OS X Lion from the Mac App Store just once in order to upgrade large numbers of Macs.

Since the software on every Mac is created by the same company that makes the Mac, you get a fully integrated system in which everything works together perfectly. OS X works with the processor in your Mac to deliver the best possible performance. The Multi-Touch trackpad on every Mac notebook gives you more than enough space to pinch, swipe, and tap your way around most of the apps on your system. OS X gives you long battery life by dimming the screen in low-light conditions and even regulating processor activity between keystrokes.

Difference Between D5 and D9

Question has been asked about what is the difference between DVD-5 and DVD-9, DVD+R and DVD RW, etc. Generally speaking, there are 4 different DVD Disc in market now. The most commonly used Disc to save video movies is D9 and D5. And the size of them can be kind of confusing for users.

First, DVD5 is cheaper than DVD9. If you want to make more copies of your favorite DVD movies, you'd better choose DVD5 disc to backup, it will save a lot of money.

Second, also another important thing: D5 is reusable and environmentally friendly disc.

You can see the disc you bought, which always display DVD-RW, DVD-R, etc. on their covers. A DVD-R is a write-once format, once you've burned the data onto that DVD platter, the disk is forever frozen with that information. Add the "W" to that, and you'll find that DVD-RW can be erased or rewritten up to a thousand times. In a similar way, the DVD+RW is defined as "DVD ReWritable" and DVD+R is defined as "DVD Recordable".

The DVD-RW and DVD+RW we always see at the market are DVD5 disc, it means that if you want to rewrite your DVD disc, you should choose DVD5 disc to backup your DVD Movies and data, you can reuse your DVD5 disc to backup different movies or data, such as write, erase, write, erase, again and again.

Difference D5 and D9: DVD-5 (Single Side Single Layer)

D5 holds around 4 700 000 000 bytes and that is 4.37 computer GB where 1 kbyte is 1024 bytes*. DVD+R/DVD+RW and DVD-R/DVD-RW support this format. This is the most common DVD Media, often called 4.7 GB Media. A DVD-5 disc will hold nominally 133 minutes of high quality MPEG-2 encoded video, together with three surround-sound audio channels and four subtitle channels. (Without video compression one DVD-5 disc would hold only about 3 minutes of video).

Difference D5 and D9: DVD-10 (Dual Side Single Layer)

D10 holds around 9 400 000 000 bytes and that is 8.75 computer GB. DVD+R/DVD+RW and DVD-R/DVD-RW support this format. A DVD-10 disc will hold a nominal 133 minutes on each side (ie 266 minutes in all), but the disc needs to be turned over to play the other side.

Difference D5 and D9: DVD-9, (Single Side Dual Layer)

D9 holds around 8 540 000 000 bytes and that is 7.95 computer GB. DVD+R support this format. This media is called DVD+R9, DVD+R DL or 8.5 GB Media. A DVD-9 (dual layer) disc and hold 240 minutes of continuous video.

Difference D5 and D9: DVD-18, (Dula side Dual Layer)

D18 holds around 17 080 000 000 bytes and that is 15.9 computer GB. DVD+R supports this format. DVD -18 can hold 240 minutes on each side and the disc needs to be turned over to play the other side.

DVD+R/DVD+RW/DVD+R DL and DVD-R/DVD-RW exact sizes

DVD-R/DVD-RW = 4 706 074 624 bytes (4488 MB)

DVD+R/DVD+RW = 4 700 372 992 bytes (4482 MB)

DVD+R DL = 8 547 993 600 bytes (8152 MB)

iOS 4.3.5 Perfect Jailbreak by Redsn0w

It seems that every time Apple issues a new software update for its iOS devices, a jailbreak angel is losing its wings. This time around we have iOS 4.3.5, which we've seen get official already as Apple is interested in patching more security flaws. iOS 4.3.5 is Apple's second security update to iOS in the last week and a half or so--Apple released iOS 4.3.4 on July 15, which fixed the flaw that Jailbreak.me 3.0 took advantage of.

As we know, earlier today (Monday), Apple released iOS 4.3.5, a security update that patches a flaw in its handling of security certificates. If you're looking to jailbreak 4.3.5, though, here's some good news: "MuscleNerd" of the iPhone Dev Team decided he would check to see if Redsn0w would successfully jailbreak the minor update. You can, however there are still a few pitfalls.

Users should download the update via iTunes when their iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch is plugged into their computer, just as easy as the process about

how

to transfer music from ipod to computer. The new update iOS 4.3.5 has come up with a patch to shield iOS from PwnageTool. But

hackers have no rest. Immediately after its launch, "MuscleNerd" of the iPhone Dev Team announced that he could jailbreak it using Redsn0w tool.

Redsn0w is another tethered jailbreak exploit. You need to tether your iDevice with a computer (both Mac and Windows) for the process of jailbreaking. But once you reboot the device, the jailbreak will be removed. That means you will have to again tether the device with a PC for jailbreaking. Redsn0w will work on iPhone 3GS, iPhone 4, iPad original and iPod fourth generation. Interestingly, it won't again run on iPad 2, the device JailbreakMe 3.0 could jailbreak.

The new iOS version also includes some other security patches. Apple used to bring out security updates for its iOS whenever there is a challenge from jailbreakers.

The downside of upgrading to iOS 4.3.5 and then performing the jailbreak is that you'd only get a tethered jailbreak solution. In other words you'll have to plug the smartphone into the computer in order to boot it into a jailbroken state every time a rebooting occurs. But that's still better than nothing, and I'm sure many of you would agree. If you rely on an unlock as well, then you'll have to make sure that you preserve the baseband of your iPhone 3GS or early iPhone 4 model before going through with the iOS 4.3.5 upgrade and jailbreak.

If you're on iOS 4.3.5 and are willing to give this a try, you can download the necessary files for Redsn0w and then following the steps on Redmond Pie's website.

The Upcoming Final Fantasy Tactics on iPod Touch

As a huge game fan, what is the best game are you expecting for? I bet you must have learned that Square Enix has announced on its official European blog that Final Fantasy Tactics: War of the Lions for iPhone and iPod Touch will be hitting the App Store this Thursday, August. After receiving Apple's approval, Final Fantasy Tactics: The War of the Lions will be out on Thursday, as expected -- and it'll be priced rather highly as far as iPhone/iPod Touch games goes.

As we know, the original Final Fantasy Tactics game was released on the Playstation console in 1997 in Japan, and in 1998 in North America. It was also released on the PLAYSTATION Network in 2009. Final Fantasy Tactics: The War of the Lions, an updated version of the game, was released on the PlayStation Portable console in 2007. A PLAYSTATION Network version was released in March in Japan and in July in North America.

As an updated version of a game originally released in 1997 in Japan, it'll also be competing with countless App Store games that offer up hours of game play -- Super Stickman Golf comes to mind -- for what works out to be about 6.19% of the price. That's quite the premium for a game on the App Store, where the large majority of games are sold for \$0.99. It's not until you can get into the 150 range that you can even find apps close in price (\$9.99), and neither of those -- MLB.com At Bat 11 (#151) and Pages (#158) -- are games. If you are just an ipod and iphone user, you can transfer apps from ipod to iphone by using an ipod to computer transfer tool.

This iOS release features a number of improvements and enhancements, including an autosave/resume function, and touch controls. Only 3GS and newer iOS devices are supported - the game will not run on 3G or older iPhones and iTouches. Yes, in three days. 72 hours. That's all. Final Fantasy Tactics is finally being released for the iPhone and iPod Touch (I'd already mentioned that the iPad version arrives later in the month). You can literally feel the sweaty anticipation from here.

Shrink is a freeware DVD transcoder program for

Microsoft Windows that uses a DVD ripper to back up DVD movies. The

final versions are 3.2.0.15 (english) and 3.2.0.16 (german), all other versions like DVD Shrink 2010 are scams. As commercially-released video DVDs are typically dual layer one of DVD Shrink's functions is to process the video into lesser quality and/or discard extra content such as foreign-language soundtracks so as to fit on a single layer (4.7 GB) DVD.

DVD Shrink is freeware, and it is only to be used to create backup copies of DVDs you already own. It is illegal to make copies of rented or borrowed DVDs, or to copy them and sell them for profit. The reason we need DVD Shrink is because a regular DVD movie doesn't fit on the average 4.7gig size DVD disc, we use DVD Shrink to cut the contents down to size as to fit on the disk.

This article will provide you how can you use DVD Shrink to copy DVD movies step by step. All you need is a DVD Shrink software and you will be able to store and duplicate all your DVD discs.

To use DVD Shrink, Things you will need:

- * DVD Shrink program
- * A DVD movie to backup
- * DVD blank disc

Guide: How to Use DVD Shrink 3.2

Step 1. Start the DVD Shrink Program and choose Open Disc from the menu above.

Step 2. A box will appear. Choose which DVD drive your disk is in. Mine is in F: drive. The name of the disk will show up in brackets. In this case it is called NEW.

Step 3. Press OK. It will read the DVD.

Step 4. Shrink DVD size.

- 1) A breakdown of the movie will be displayed in the right hand column.
- 2) You cannot fit all this on your blank dvd so now press Re-author.
- 3) In the right column there will be a heading called Main movie. There will be a file under this heading. Drag this to the left column. The file size is usually more than 4,700mb and has to be compressed.

Step 5. Click on the "Backup" icon. This is where you will choose a folder for your ripped files. Once you make a folder, make sure the box is checked next to "Create VIDEO_TS and AUDIO_TS subfolders" and click "OK".

The movie will now play quickly in the viewing box, and you will see the progression of the rip. Once the rip is complete, the movie can be burned to a DVD-R automatically via DVD Shrink using NERO. Or if you have different DVD-burning software, you can open that manually and burn the ripped files as you normally would.

Review of Spy Kids 3 Game on Blu-ray

As a movie fan, especially for a kid, what movie are you expecting for in the next month? Are you also crazy about some adventure film just like me? If so, let's share another adventure film together. I bet you must be very interested in it.

Firstly, as an insider, you must have learned that Sin City director Robert Rodriguez has a penchant for blood-soaked

action films (El Mariachi, Desperado), but he's enjoyed his biggest commercial successes with his trio of family-oriented Spy Kids films, which premiered a decade ago.

The Spy Kids series is a series of family/action/adventure films written, produced and directed by Robert Rodriguez. The main plot follows the adventures of the children of a married spy couple who become involved in their parents' espionage. The rest of their family are spies as well, including their estranged uncle Machete (who supplies the OSS with gadgets) and maternal grandparents. The films tend to have a strong Hispanic heritage theme, as Rodriguez is of Mexican descent, though the dialogue is predominately in English.

Spy Kids 3: Game Over, what was in 2003 the first American 3D film released to theatres by a major studio since 1991's Freddy's Dead: The Final Nightmare, arrives on Blu-ray sans the 3D, but with a solid 2D-only high-definition transfer. If only that were enough to forgive what is a plot that is obviously lifted from another, even older film.

The younger Cortez sibling Juni is now out of the spy game and working as a private eye doing odd jobs, but he is called back into action by the President (George Clooney). There's a major new videogame, Game Over, that has all the kids going crazy to play it, but it's a threat to worldwide security. The virtual reality game is ensnaring the minds of kids all over the world and keeping them trapped in the game world. Juni's sister Carmen, still an OSS agent, was sent into the game to investigate and became trapped herself. Juni must go into the game, find his sister, and conquer the Toymaker by first beating the game's unbeatable Level 5.

With its neon-colored uniforms, virtual reality battles, cycle races and more, not to mention the very premise of being trapped in a game to start with, the whole film feels like an unapologetic rip-off of Tron (1982).

Video Quality

With each subsequent Spy Kids film the quality of the production and the image has gotten better. Spy Kids 3's AVC 1080p encodement looks the best out of the trilogy that has recently arrived on Blu-ray. If you are not a blu ray dvd player, you can also enjoy it on your nomal dvd player just by ripping blu ray movie to your computer through a

blu
ray copy

software. Like the second film, it was also captured in HD and its transfer to Blu-ray is clean and detailed with little in the way of video noise. It shows very vivid colors and strong flesh tones.

Audio Quality

The DTS-HD Master Audio 5.1 soundtrack is rather aggressive, making heavy use of the surround channels right from the beginning. There's strong low frequency extension and natural high frequencies with very clean and full sounding dialogue. Sound is spread wide across the front, which is also quite active in following sound across the screen.
