Where I wasn't allowed to play outside past 6PM. Where I would be bused to nearest Los Angeles Magnet School and never befriend those of my barrio because it would be too painful as a child to befriend someone you wouldn't even see at school. But I did! =)

I befriended Joaquin, Miguel, Beto (RIP), Karen, Luisito, Yuri and the rest of the Alvarez family. I enjoyed my childhood growing up in Koreatown.

The interesting thing is what (sorry I go back and forth) my compaÑera shared with me. Laury told me this past Saturday that it's funny and quite ironic that we both live in better places, houses, here in Mexico City than we do back in California.

I didn't register in my head til right now as I'm continuing working on my research project dealing with menores infractores.

I lived in a one bedroom duplex apartment with my mom and dad. Later I found out about my sister that was left behind in Guatemala. I thought my life in Koreatown was normal and that everyone lived like I did.

BOy was I wrong.

Now the puzzle pieces are coming together. As an adult, as a scholar, as a human being and above all as a mujer I see life, I see love and I see my work as water (maybe a little corny, but true) . Water is a fundamental element in life and without it we the human race as we know it wouldn't exist. But yet there so much more for me to learn from life.

But also I make reference to the metaphor of water, because my work, love and life is like water. It is fundamental but its like water in a desert, like freakin' California, where it dries up, it is soaked up and it is dehydration one after another in all my stages of life where I give it my all like someone once told me instead of giving a hand i give my whole arm and the water is scarce in lands like California, in the desert, and I intake water only when i stop by an oasis and it's not that frequent. I die inside, i cry inside, i sweat tears and blood and water, the H2O element of life, just pours right out of me and I'm left empty inside without more of that agua de vida. I need to refuel, I need more love, more work put into ME, more Life given to ME.

If I can save a life through my work and my love and in return just get more FRESH Water from the fountain of life into my body, soul, and heart, then I can SEE again clearly and continue what I know best to do: WORK, LIVE, AND LOVE.

Bueno yo tengo una ventaja que yo ya conozco que trabajo hace Osvaldo. Y me encanta el trabajo de el equipo y me encante el por eso.

Platicando con Staci ayer que pasamos y vimos que hay un lugar a la par de Pizza Bowl en Tres Cruces, decia el letrero "Hamburguesas por 28 pesos con papas". Yo me meti y estaban tocando Sistem (enMx spanish) of a Down y yo y Staci platicando me di cuenta sola en compania de ella que a mi gusta Osvaldo. Pero en realidad no es tanto que me guste pero es una admiracion por lo que el es y todo lo que el representa. Yo no habia encontrado a alguien como el, ni lo habia pensado que me pudiera gustar.

El es humilde, sincero, cariñoso, de lentes igual que yo, pero ve mucho mas alla de lo que es porque ve con el sentimiento, y es rockero de corazon (tiene un gusto de musica y le tiene un afan a musica que a mi gustaba antes de chava, pero el de 29 anos todavia lo escucha). That last example brings us to another thing you need to bear in mind as you do analogy questions. The relationships you need to explain will be constant relationships, words that ALWAYS relate to each other in a specific way.

What do we mean? Well, practically speaking, you might get a word pair like the one we just saw:

DANCE : GYMNASIUM

But you're far more likely to see one like:

DANCE : BALLROOM

A ballroom is designed to hold dances, and so the two words always stand in that relationship. By contrast, sometimes a gymnasium is used for dances, and sometimes for sports events.

What you definitely won't see is a pair like BOOK SALE : GYMNASIUM. While book sales have been known to be held in gymnasiums, the two words don't have a constant, standing relationship to one another.

Demosthenes is known to have delivered only three Philippics; in contrast, the Philippics of the Roman statesman Marcus Tullius Cicero attacking Marc Antony some 300 years later -- "orationes philippicae" in Latin (so-named because of their similarity to Demosthenes' orations) -- numbered fourteen. We still capitalize the word when we refer to these famous diatribes, but ever since 1592, "philippic" has been used (usually in lowercase) in a broader sense as well.

Although "dÃ©gringolade" retains the sense of a sudden tumble in English, it tends to be applied to more metaphorical situations -- a rapid fall from a higher position in society, for example. These days, "dÃ©gringolade" is fairly rare in American English. We rely far more heavily on its familiar synonym "downfall."

This belief not only led to the extended use of "jaundiced," but it also resulted in a similar use of the adjective "bilious," which can mean either "ill-tempered" or "marked by or suffering from liver dysfunction and especially excessive secretion of bile."

No one is really sure about the origin of "logy," but experts speculate that it comes from the Dutch word "log," meaning "heavy." Its first recorded use in English, from an 1847 London newspaper, refers to a "loggy stroke" in rowing.

Two related adjectives -- "emulate" and "emulous" -- appeared around the same time as the verb "emulate." Both mean "striving to emulate" or sometimes "jealous," but "emulous" is rare these days, and the adjective "emulate" is obsolete. The latter did have a brief moment of glory, however, when Shakespeare used it in Hamlet:

"Our last king,

Whose image even but now appear'd to us,

Was, as you know, by Fortinbras of Norway,

Thereto prick'd on by a most emulate pride,

Dar'd to the combat. . ."

"Beneficial" usually applies to things that promote well-being (as in "beneficial treatment"), or that provide some benefit or advantage (as in "beneficial classes"). "Beneficent" means doing or effecting good (as in "a beneficent climate"), but in particular refers to the performance of acts of kindness or charity (as in "a beneficent organization"). "Benefic," the rarest of the three, tends to be a bit high-flown, and it's mostly used to describe a favorable power or force.

The Bell Curve and The GCP from Princeton

The Bell Curve is a controversial, best-selling 1994 book by the late Harvard professor Richard J. Herrnstein and American Enterprise Institute political scientist Charles Murray. Its central point is that intelligence is a better predictor of many factors including financial income, job performance, unwed pregnancy, and crime than parents' socioeconomic status or education level. Also, the book argued that those with high intelligence, which it called the "cognitive elite", are becoming separated from the general population of those with average and below-average intelligence and that this was a dangerous social trend. Much of the controversy concerned Chapters 13 and 14, in which the authors wrote about the enduring racial differences in intelligence and discuss implications of those differences. The authors were reported throughout the popular press as arguing that these IQ differences are genetic, and they did indeed write in chapter 13 "It seems highly likely to us that both genes and the environment have something to do with racial differences." The introduction to the chapter more cautiously states, "The debate about whether and how much genes and environment have to do with ethnic differences remains unresolved."

Their evidence comes from an analysis of data compiled in the National Longitudinal Study of Youth (NLSY), a study conducted by the U.S. Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics tracking thousands of Americans starting in the 1980s. All participants in the NLSY took the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB), a battery of ten tests taken by all who apply for entry into the armed services.

In response to the growing controversy surrounding The Bell Curve, the American Psychological Association's Board of Scientific Affairs established a special task force to publish an investigative report on the research presented in the book.[4] The final report, titled Intelligence: Knowns and Unknowns, is available at an academic website. [5]
