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PRP Hair Restoration Treatment for Hair Loss: Efficacy and its Cost

Platelet-rich plasma is a medical procedure where blood is drawn out, processed, and injected into the scalp. This process is believed to trigger natural hair growth. PRP is also believed to maintain hair growth by raising blood supply to the hair follicles. This process also increases the thickness of the hair shaft.

****Step 3; ****the layer with platelet-rich plasma will be collected and injected in the areas where the hair loss has occurred.

PRP effectiveness on hair loss restorations has not yet been proved. It is also not clear who should undergo this process or under what situations is it most successful. PRP for transplant is still growing, and its clinical proof is still poor.

PRP for Hair Loss Side Effects

There is no risk of getting any communicable disease during this process. Because it has to do blood injection into the scalp. But still, there are a few side effects, which includes;

- Some infections
- An injury to your nerve or blood vessel.
- A scared tissue

Make sure to let the doctor know your tolerance to the anesthetic that is used in the therapy because you can have a negative reaction to the anesthetic that will be used in the treatment.

PRP for Hair Loss Risks

Make sure to report all the medical treatments you are on before the PRP procedure. Also include the herbs and the extra. The PRP procedure will be risky to those patients who smoke a lot or those with a history of drug abuse.

If you have been on blood thinners, you should not opt for PRP for hair because it will be risky.

1. Steam rooms, saunas, and swimming pools for 28 days.
2. Direct sunlight to the scalp for 28 days.
3. Heavy exercises or work for five days.
4. The patient also needs to moisturize the scalp after every treatment.
