If your medical doctor has not been successful in treating your headaches, neck aches or pain around your jaw, ear, or temple, it's time to see a cosmetic dentist.

Over time, tooth enamel is susceptible to staining from many common foods and drinks. Aging brings with it a tendency of teeth to yellow or darken. Some people have naturally dark teeth. While this is more cosmetic than health-related, tooth whitening is the most common of the cosmetic treatments.
