On How to Convert MP4 to AVI

MP4 (MPEG-4 Part 14) is a multimedia container format standard specified as a part of MPEG-4. Nowadays, more and more movies and videos are encoded in the MP4 file format which can deliver good video quality. And it has become more familiar to people who like watching and sharing videos online.

Though Mp4 is very popular and has been used in many ways, it can only be surpported by many devices. Avi videos are more common, so we can convert mp4 to avi format with a

free mp4 to avi converter

. Then, how to do it?

Step1. Click "Add Video" icon to import your MP4 files in or select them and drag them to the program. Double click the file name to have an instant preview.

Select your file, and choose "AVI-Audio-Video Interleaved (*.avi)" in the droplist of "Profile".

Set your output destination folder in "Output".

Step2. Click "Edit" icon to adjust the video effects, trim for a video clip and crop for a proper video dimension.

Step 3: Settings.

Step4. Click "Convert" in the bottom right on the main interface to start the conversion, and done. Fast conversion speed!

What is AVCHD $\ddot{1}^{1}/_{4}$

AVCHD (Advanced Video Coding High Definition) is a file-based format for the digital recording and playback of high-definition video.

Developed jointly by Sony and Panasonic, the format

was introduced in 2006 primarily for use in high definition consumer camcorders. Favorable comparisons of AVCHD against HDV and XDCAM EX solidified perception of AVCHD as a format acceptable for professional usage. Panasonic released the first professional AVCHD camcorder in autumn of 2008, followed by Sony in the first quarter of 2010.

In 2011 the AVCHD specification has been amended to include 1080-line 50-frame/s and 60-frame/s formats and stereoscopic video. The new modes also allowed higher system data rate than existing modes.

AVCHD and its logo are trademarks of Panasonic and Sony.
