Reconstructing the shape of your nose will allow better airflow and help you breathe freely during sleep. Structural abnormalities of the nose are also known to be associated with Sleep Apnea. This condition causes you to temporarily stop breathing because of narrowed or blocked airways. After undergoing rhinoplasty, symptoms associated with sleep apnea such as difficulty breathing, snoring, and waking up in the middle of the night may disappear. Eliminating these symptoms will help you become more relaxed at night and increase the chances of getting better sleep.

By having normal breathing patterns at night, you can naturally activate the sympathetic and parasympathetic systems. These systems are responsible for regulating your internal organs and your overall well being. Last, negative thoughts that we may have during the day can creep into our nights and cause us to lose sleep. Reconstructing the appearance of an asymmetric nose, we could eliminate negative thoughts that we hold of ourselves, and
